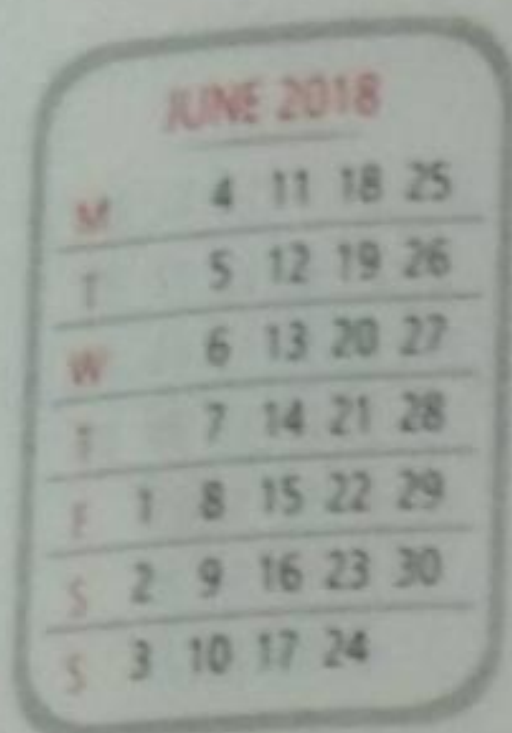

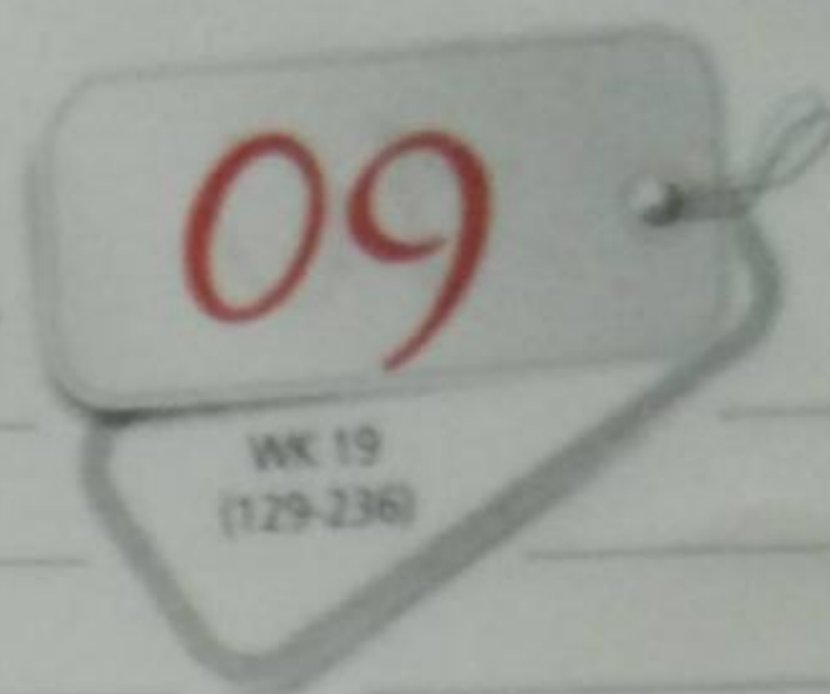

Plural = A Noun that Names More than one person, animal, place or thing is called a plural Noun.

for Ex = four cats, Two trees, five pens etc.
